Projects are original, creative, shared in the community and include performances with Jon Lord (Former keyboard player and founder member of Deep Purple) Gordon Giltrap, and a world premiere performance of Malcolm Singer's new work played with the Yehudi Menuhin School Orchestra and which will be choreographed. Players range in age from twelve to twenty five and we have a structure which allows musicians from grade three to those entering the music profession. 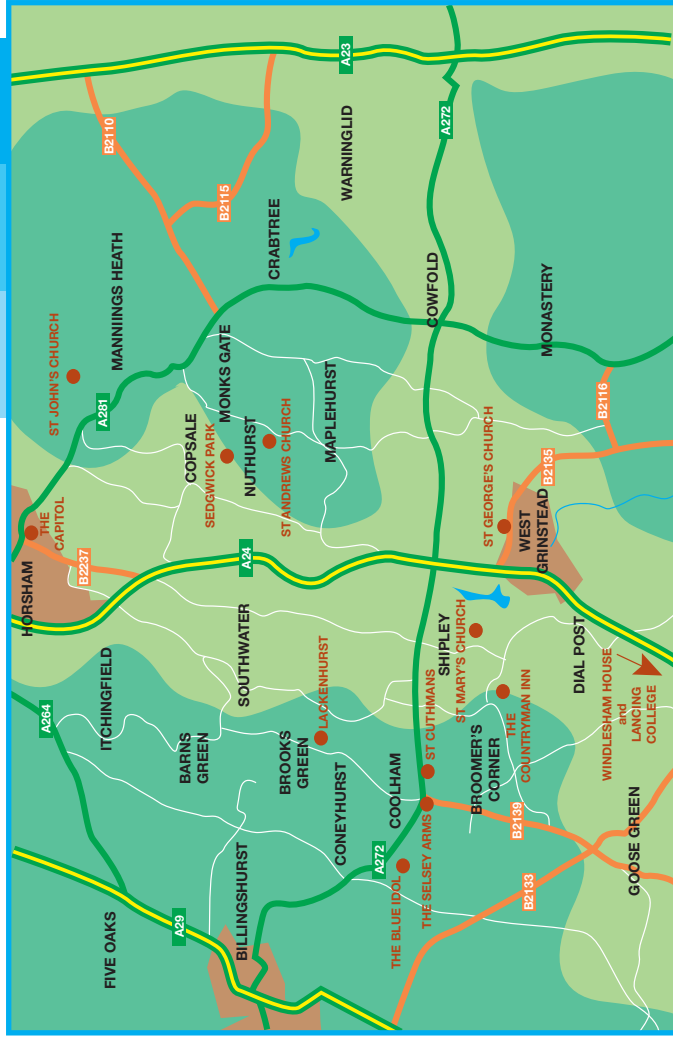
